Student Conduct Code

Iowa Mennonite School acknowledges Jesus Christ as Lord over all areas of life. In applying for admission to IMS, each student indicates a desire to learn more about Jesus and His teachings as well as to grow into a relationship with Jesus that includes all aspects of life. Each student is encouraged to develop honest, respectful and caring relationships with fellow students, faculty, parents and community persons.

IMS is committed to a redemptive discipline in which counsel, support and encouragement are given to those students who may develop a problem and who sincerely want to overcome the problem. Students are asked to abstain from behavior that is harmful to themselves and to others. The use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, profanity, dishonesty and malicious and disrespectful conduct is unacceptable behavior.

Continued student involvement in any of these activities, as well as other activities that consistently distract from the total program at IMS, will show the faculty and administration that the student is not interested in living a life compatible with the example and teaching of Jesus Christ. Such a student will be asked to leave Iowa Mennonite School.
