CAMP PURPOSE:

IMS Basketball Camp will seek to provide sound instruction of basketball fundamentals within an environment also conducive to personal growth and spiritual development. It is imperative that each camper come with an attitude of openness to what is involved in becoming a better person as well as a better basketball player.

CAMP DIRECTOR: Dwight Gingerich



Coach Gingerich has been at IMS for 29 years, and also served as Interim Head Coach at Goshen (IN) College, where he received Mid-Central Conference coach of the Year honors in 2001. His IMS teams have been consistently ranked in the state's Top 10, and the 2011 team recently concluded a 24-2 season with the school's 11th trip to the state tournament. Coach Gingerich was named State Coach of the Year in 2007 and was named a National High School Coach of the Year Finalist in 2010. He has coached 25 all-state players and his teams have won over 500 games in his career.

CAMP STAFF will include:

Aaron Gingerich recently completed his first season as the Junior Varsity coach at IMS. Coach Gingerich is passionate about teaching the game and loves to work with young people. He was a key contributor on the IMS '05 state runner-up team and holds the school's career assist record. He played at Bethel (KS) College and teaches Physical Education at IMS.

Luke Yoder recently completed his first season as freshman coach at IMS. Coach Yoder starred at IMS and played on the '04 state tournament team. He ranks third in career threes made. Coach Yoder is a 2008 graduate of Eastern Mennonite University with a degree in Economics and is employed with Emery Gingerich. Coach Yoder brings strong organizational skills and a passion for the game to the program.

Randy Miller, a 1996 IMS grad, currently teaches 5th grade and coaches the 8th grade team at Panorama Middle School. A long-time camp veteran, Coach Miller brings a high level of energy and enjoyment to our camp each summer.

Additional staff will consist of current high school coaches and college and high school players.

REGISTRATION

ELIGIBILITY

IMS Basketball Camp is open to girls and boys entering grades 1-10.

COST
