The **Iowa Youth Writing Project (IYWP)** is a volunteer-powered non-profit outreach collective that aims to empower, inspire, and educate Iowa's K-12 youth using language arts and creative expression. Founded in 2010 by graduates of the Iowa Writers' Workshop, the IYWP seeks to enfold young writers into Eastern Iowa's nationally recognized literary scene by providing a space in which the voices of K-12 students can be amplified, celebrated, and showcased publicly.

The IYWP provides one-of-a-kind writing, publishing, and creative learning opportunities to Iowa's children and teens. Operating under the belief that writing skills (and confidence in using them) can empower any student to become a self-advocate, the IYWP's programming focuses on the generative process, offering students the opportunity to hone their voices in a judgment-free atmosphere, using open-ended prompts and activities to maximize creative freedom.
